

CSR Projects Undertaken by BELSTAR in FY 2025–2026

Flood Relief Initiative –Latur & Solapur Regions in Maharashtra

In September 2025, unusually heavy rainfall caused severe flooding across drought-prone regions of Maharashtra, including Solapur and Latur districts. The floods persisted for over a week, cutting off access to more than 65 villages and severely disrupting livelihoods. Many families were left without access to food and essential supplies, with children being the most vulnerable.

In response, **Belstar Microfinance Limited** launched a timely CSR initiative to support affected customers by distributing essential grocery kits. The intervention was focused across five severely impacted branches Ausa, Killari, Deglur, Avanti Nagar, and Mohol—ensuring coverage of the most affected communities.

Each grocery kit included basic food essentials such as rice, cooking oil, sugar, tea, and pigeon peas, aimed at addressing immediate nutritional needs. Belstar’s field staff played a key role in executing the distribution efficiently and reaching beneficiaries despite logistical challenges.

Through this initiative, a total of **521 beneficiaries** were supported, with an overall expenditure of **₹2.63 lakh**. The relief effort helped alleviate immediate distress, ensured food security for vulnerable households, and reinforced trust among members.

This initiative reflects Belstar’s strong commitment to social responsibility and its proactive approach in supporting communities during times of crisis. By responding swiftly and effectively, Belstar continues to strengthen its role as a responsible and community-focused organization.

Belstar incurred a total expenditure of ₹2,62,986 for this relief effort, with an average cost of approximately ₹505 per beneficiary.



Flood Relief Initiative – Moinaguri Region in West Bengal

In October 2025, severe flooding caused by extreme weather conditions impacted the Siliguri region of West Bengal, particularly areas under the Moinaguri Branch. Nearly 17 villages were affected, with Betgara, Charerbari, Kurshamari, Bagribari, Dharmapur, and Balapara among the worst hit. Floodwaters persisted for over a week, disrupting livelihoods, isolating communities, and restricting access to essential supplies.

Response and Impact

Belstar Microfinance Limited responded promptly by launching a targeted CSR initiative to support affected communities. The intervention focused on providing immediate relief through the distribution of grocery kits and blankets to ensure food security and protection against adverse weather conditions.

Key Highlights

- **Target Beneficiaries:** 62 severely affected families
- **Geographical Focus:** Moinaguri Branch villages, West Bengal
- **Total Expenditure:** ₹60,000/-
- **Implementation:** Direct distribution by Belstar staff

Relief Kit Composition

Each beneficiary received a kit containing:

- **Grocery Items:** Rice, Dal, Sugar, Salt, Biscuit, Oil
- **Sanitary Items:** Dettol, Soap
- **Essential Item:** Blanket

The initiative provided timely support to vulnerable families during a critical period, addressing immediate needs such as food, hygiene, and warmth. It helped alleviate distress caused by the disaster and ensured basic sustenance for affected households. The relief effort was well received by the community, with beneficiaries expressing gratitude for the prompt assistance. The initiative also strengthened Belstar's presence and trust within the community.

This CSR initiative reflects Belstar Microfinance Limited's strong commitment to social responsibility and community welfare. By acting swiftly in times of crisis, the organization continues to play a vital role in supporting vulnerable populations and fostering resilient communities. **Belstar incurred a total expenditure of ₹60,000 for this initiative, with an average cost of approximately ₹968 per beneficiary.**



Medical Camps - Tamilnadu and Pondicherry

BELSTAR successfully organized and conducted a total of 26 General Medical Camps and 16 Eye Camps across 42 locations in Tamil Nadu during January and February 2026. In addition, 2 General Medical Camps were conducted in Pondicherry during the same period. These camps were primarily aimed at reaching underserved rural populations with limited access to healthcare services.

Beneficiaries were mobilized with the support of local Panchayat Presidents, ward members, volunteers, and government officials, ensuring strong community participation.

A multidisciplinary team was engaged to provide comprehensive health care, including

- ❖ Gynaecologists
- ❖ Paediatricians
- ❖ ENT
- ❖ Dermatologists
- ❖ Ophthalmologists
- ❖ Orthopaedic surgeons
- ❖ Nurses and paramedical staff

The camps were held at community centres and Panchayat/Town Panchayat buildings to ensure easy accessibility for the public. Key health services provided included:

- ❖ General health check-ups
- ❖ Height and weight measurement
- ❖ Blood pressure monitoring
- ❖ Blood sugar testing
- ❖ Dental check-ups
- ❖ Eye examinations
- ❖ ECG screenings

All essential medicines were provided free of cost to the beneficiaries.

Patients requiring advanced medical intervention particularly for conditions such as varicose veins and cataracts were referred to nearby hospitals. Follow-ups were conducted to ensure the completion of treatment.

A total of 7,232 individuals benefited from these camps, including,

- ❖ Men - 2322
- ❖ Women - 4576
- ❖ Children - 334

Among them, 906 patients were referred for further treatment. Notably, 63 patients underwent cataract surgery, and free spectacles were provided to support their post-surgical vision care.

BELSTAR incurred a total expenditure of ₹6,51,196 in organizing these medical camps, with an average cost of approximately ₹90 per beneficiary.
